
THE ADAM V'ADAMA SCHOOL NETWORK IS ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL IN THE GAZA ENVELOPE



A new Adam V'Adama school is set to be established in the Eshkol region with support from the Poalim Foundation for Recovery, by Bank Hapoalim. This initiative will expand the current network of schools to a total of six, with Adam V'Adama Eshkol becoming the first school to be established in the western Negev area since October 7th. The school's primary aim is to strengthen the resilience of farmers in the Gaza envelope and contribute to the renewal of local settlements and communities. The school will achieve this by empowering youth through the values of labor and a love of the land. This new school represents a crucial step in the rehabilitation and revitalization of the Gaza envelope region.
